- All food vendors must meet the requirements of Central Vancouver Island Health Region: Food Vendor application permit and/or Temporary Food Permit's must be received by June 1, 2023.
- > All applications are subject to approval.
- > This is a rain or shine event, no refunds or discounts are available for poor weather.
- > Vendors are required to be present for BOTH days, there is no overnight security.

## **EVENT PROCESS**

- Vendors may start set-up at 8:00 am on Saturday and 9:00 am on Sunday. Vendors are required to be open for business from 10:30 am – 6:00 pm on Saturday & 10:30 am – 4:30 pm on Sunday, NO EARLY TAKE DOWNS PERMITTED.
- Fair grounds open to the public at 10:30 am both Saturday and Sunday.
- Vehicles can access the site for set up/take down when fairgrounds are not occupied; once you have unloaded/loaded your goods, immediately remove your vehicles to the rear parking area under the alder trees, do not park by the back stop. If you require your vehicle to stay onsite with supplies, please indicate on application.
- Vendors must keep belongings within their site boundary, signs and belongings are not to block pedestrian traffic.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up ALL GARBAGE & RECYCLING around their area. Garbage must be removed from grounds to dumpster each day.
- Dry camping is available on the perimeters of the grounds for "out of town vendors", spots are limited and must be requested in advance. Please indicate if you would like to camp: \_\_\_\_\_\_\_
- Friday night arrival must be pre-arranged.
- Vendors will be given a maximum of four weekend passes or six day passes for the Fairgrounds. You may purchase more if needed.

- Pets are not allowed on the Fairgrounds, no exceptions.
