- Vehicles can access the site for set up/take down when fairgrounds are not occupied; once you have unloaded/loaded your goods, immediately remove your vehicles to the rear parking area under the alder trees, do not park by the back stop.
- Vendors must keep belongings within their site boundary, signs and belongings are not to block pedestrian traffic or view of neighbours display.

- Vendors will be given a maximum of four weekend passes or six day passes for the Fairgrounds. You may purchase more if needed. Please note what your choice is: \_\_\_\_\_\_
